Rules & How to Enter

1. All contestants **MUST BE** at the fairgrounds and checked in by 9:00 A.M. for rehearsal. Attire for rehearsal is up to the contestant, this is not a judged category and is closed to the public. After rehearsal, contestants will be dismissed to change and prepare for interview and sportswear/swimwear competitions.
2. Age Qualifications
 - a. JR. Queen: Contestant must be at least 14 years of age and no more than 17 years of age on the opening day of the Benton County Fair (August 4, 2019) and must be a legal resident of Benton County.
 - b. Miss: Contestant must be at least 18 years of age and no more than 23 years of age on the opening day of the Benton County Fair (August 4, 2019) and must be a legal resident of Benton County.
 - c. **Contestant must be a legal resident of Benton County. This means you must LIVE in Benton County. Per State Fair rules, going to school in the county does not constitute residency.**

4. HOW TO ENTER
 - a. **NEW!!!** From now until August 1st you will have the opportunity to submit your entry form and payment online!! Once early registration has ended, you must bring your entry form to the door with your \$75 entry fee, NO EXCEPTIONS.
 - b. **For the early registration, you must register and pay online by August 1st to receive the discount, NO EXCEPTIONS.** It will be \$40 and there is a \$2.00 processing fee. You will also click the link in "Tips" to have access to the entry form, please fill this out. ***If you are entering more than one person online-select "Quick Group" this way you only have to pay the processing fee one time!***
 - i. **Early registration website** is <https://bentonar.fairwire.com>

- ii. Check in for early registration will end at 9:00 am, NO EXCEPTIONS. If you are not checked in by this time you will be disqualified and unable to receive a refund for your entry fee.
- c. At the door registration will be open on August 4th. This is ONLY OPEN FROM 8:00-9:00 AM. Please come with your \$75 entry fee and THREE copies of completed paperwork. At 9:00 am, registration will be OFFICIALLY CLOSED, NO EXCEPTIONS. If you show up after 9:00 am, you will NOT be allowed to compete.
- d. DO NOT MAIL YOUR FORM TO THE FAIRGROUNDS.

MORNING COMPETITIONS

Rehearsal

1. Registration will conclude and orientation will begin at 9:00 am. Rehearsal will start at 9:00 am. You MUST be registered and checked in at this time in order to compete, no exceptions.
2. All contestants will receive their numbers when they check in.
3. Since the rehearsal is closed to the public, contestants are free to wear comfortable clothing, hair in curlers and no makeup if desired. We recommend the contestants rehearse in the same shoes they will wear in each phase of competition.

Interview and Sportswear/Swimwear

1. Directly following rehearsal, morning competitions will begin. There will not be a dressing room available during this time, but contestants will be free to change in the restrooms located at the back of the auditorium.
2. Private Interviews will begin at 11:00 am.
 - a. Attire is as follows; Dress or Suit, Jewelry and shoes of choice – no hats, gloves or purses. There will be no dressing rooms at this time. Contestants will need to change in the restrooms located in the back of the building.
 - b. This will account for 50 percent of a contestant's total score. All interviews will be five minutes long and will be timed and monitored. Judges are instructed to avoid current affairs and religious or political questions. The Judges and Contestants are not allowed to shake hands or have any physical contact.
3. Sportswear/Swimwear competition will be directly following interview.
 - a. Private Sportswear(Jr. Queen): Sports attire representing favorite athletic-type sport such as baseball, tennis, cheerleading, hunting, fishing, gymnastics, dance, etc. Props are acceptable, but must be carried. They cannot be used to demonstrate the sport being modeled.

- b. Private Swimwear(Miss): One piece swimsuit, shoes and accessories of choice. Swimsuit must be MODEST. High heels are recommended, but not required. No tankinis or monokinis allowed. Sarongs may be worn but MAY NOT be removed during contestants modeling pattern.
 - c. **Sportswear/Swimwear**: 15% of the contestants overall score. Over-all first impression, physical fitness, energy level, posture, poise, personality, stage presence, and confidence are taken into account. All males will be asked to step out of the auditorium and all females not competing must go to the back.
4. Following the interview and sportswear/swimwear competitions, contestants will be free to leave and come back for later competitions.

EVENING COMPETITIONS

1. All contestants will need to be back at the fairgrounds by **4:30 P.M** for fair wear and evening gown and onstage question. You will sit in the audience until your age group is called backstage for lineup. We will start with the PreTeens and end with the Ms. contestants. There will **NOT** be a dressing room available to change in at this time. Once again, contestants are free to use the restrooms located in the back of the auditorium to change.
2. Only contestants are allowed in free. You must show your contestant completed pageant entry form to the gate personnel to be allowed to enter free. (Unless the fair is having sponsored admission-then it is free for everyone).
3. Evening Gown/Onstage Question
 - a. Evening gown attire is as follows; Evening Gown of choice. Jewelry and accessories should be tasteful and compliment the gown. High-heeled shoes are recommended, but not required.
 - b. The Evening Gown Competition will account for 35 percent of a contestant's total score. Judging will be based on overall first impression, beauty, stage presence, personality, grace, charm, walk, appropriateness of evening gown and composite appearance. Each contestant will be asked an on-stage question and will be allowed a maximum of 30 seconds for their extemporaneous response, her ability to answer confidently, as well as her tone of voice, will be included in her Evening Gown score. Judges are instructed "not to judge the gown", but to "judge the contestant in the gown."
4. Winners receive rhinestone crowns, sashes, and a prize package. Runner ups will receive a certificate. An Overall Interview and Overall Fair Wear award will be given to the contestants who receive the highest score in each

- competition. Audience Favorite award will be given to the contestant who receives the most votes in each age group. Votes are \$1.00 each.
5. Ms winner will be required to compete at the State Fair Pageant in October.
 6. Winner must attend all events and complete all duties outlined in Miss Benton County Fair Queen and Jr. Fair Queen contracts. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of title and all winnings. First runner up will take over at this time.
 7. Audience Favorite ballots are available to print off. You are welcome to pre collect votes and bring them the night of the pageant along with the collected money. You may also print off more ballots than what are attached if needed. We will also be collecting votes throughout the pageant. Pre-collection of votes is strictly OPTIONAL. Audience Favorite competition does NOT have any deciding factor in the overall winner.

The judges will be appointed by the Benton County Fair Pageant. They will be persons well qualified to judge a competition of this kind. Their decision will be final. Critiques and scores will not be provided to anyone, nor will any contestant, or any representative of a contestant, be allowed to approach the judges at any time.

The Benton Co. Fair Pageant Director reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with, or incident to the contest, and the right to amend or add to these rules as their judgment may determine. Any contestant who fails to abide by any of the above rules can be disqualified from the competition by the County Contest Director and/or County Fair Management.
